The following stipulations are in effect for SECC member schools:

- A member school must believe in salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. Good works, such as baptism and church membership, are not part of the salvation experience. (Please see SECC Statement of Faith for a more detailed list of Christian doctrine requirements for SECC member and probationary schools.)
- A member school must agree to abide by all dress code guidelines and all policies of the SECC (See dress code in the SECC By-laws. Failure to conform with SECC rules and regulations will result in the termination of school membership in the Conference.
- It will be the responsibility of the school administration to make sure that the coaches and fans conduct themselves in such a way as to honor the Lord.
- The school acknowledges that the SECC is not responsible for student injury. This is the sole responsibility of the member school. Each school must provide student accident insurance for its participants.
- Home-schoolers participating in member school's sports program must be registered with the member school and apply to participate in the SouthEastern Christian Conference. Member schools are responsible for all home school students representing their school. A member school may not use students that are enrolled in any other middle school, junior high, or high school. No participating student athlete may be over 19 years 9 months in age.
